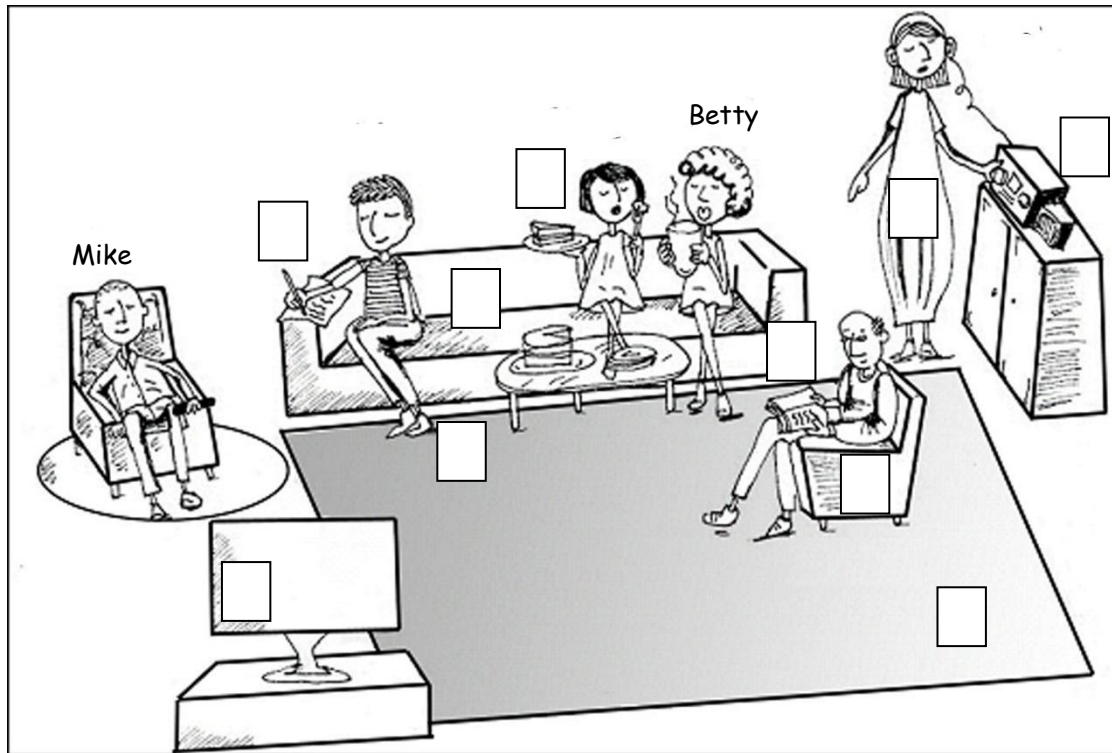

Sharon and Tim are on holiday in Australia. Today they are at the zoo. They are listening to information about marsupials. Marsupials are Australian animals that carry their babies in a pouch. Their babies are called joeys.

Kangaroos are nocturnal. Nocturnal animals sleep during the day and are awake at night. They are herbivores and eat grass and leaves. They can go for months without drinking water. Some kangaroos are red; others are grey or brown in colour.

Koalas are nocturnal too and sleep for about 20 hours a day. They are arboreal, which means that they live in trees. They are herbivores and eat eucalyptus leaves. They drink very little water. They don't have tails. They are grey or brown in colour.

Tasmanian devils are found in Tasmania. They are nocturnal and live alone. They are carnivores; which means they eat other animals. Tasmanian devils are black and have pink ears that turn red when they are excited. They are noisy animals.
