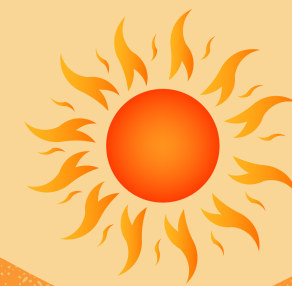


CVC & 2 SYLLABLE WORDS



Two-syllable or more verb with stressed final syllable – Double the last letter
Two-syllable or more verb with stressed first syllable – Do not double the last letter

Stress on the final syllable – Double the last letter

upset – upsetting

She was upsetting all the people in the room with her loud voice.

Examples

begin, forget,
admit, upset,

Stress on the first syllable – Do not double the last letter

open – opening

He was opening his mail when the phone rang.

Examples

listen, visit,
enter, open
