Domino

Cut along the dotted lines. There are 12 domino pieces.

Shuffle the cards and deal them equally among the students, except for one card. This will be the beginning card.

The teacher places this card in the middle of the group and asks the students, "Do you have blue or yellow?" The students that have those cards say, "I have blue." "I have yellow." They place their cards next to the domino card that is their, on the correct side.

The teacher then asks about the next two end colours. Play carries on until all the cards have been used.
