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How to play:

You will need counters. There is one board and 35 cards.

Cut the cards up.

Place the cards face down in a pile next to the board.

The students place their counters on START

Each student in turn, picks up a card.

If the student picks up an 'a' card the student moves to the *nearest* square with a noun that starts with a consonant and says, "I have **a tree**".

If the student picks up an 'an' card the student moves to the *nearest* square with a noun that starts with a vowel and says, "I have **an egg**".

If the student picks up a 'some' card the student moves to the nearest square with a noun in the plural or a non-count noun and says, "I can see **some boys**".

The students move along the board according to the cards they pick up.

The winner is the first student to reach FINISH
