## MOVE ALONG - A / ANY / SOME

How to play:
You will need counters. There is one board and 35 cards.
Cut the cards up.
Place the cards face down in a pile next to the board.
The students place their counters on START
Each student in turn, picks up a card.
If the student picks up an ' $a$ ' card the student moves to the nearest square with a noun
that starts with a consonant and says, "I have a tree".
If the student picks up an 'an' card the student moves to the nearest square with a noun that starts with a vowel and says, "I have an egg".
If the student picks up a 'some' card the student moves to the nearest square with a noun in the plural or a non-count noun and says, "I can see some boys".

The students move along the board according to the cards they pick up.
The winner is the first student to reach FINISH
